A Mother's Tears

"A Mother's Tears" is an art installation that explores the emotional connection between the artist and her creations, depicting the delicate and fragile nature of the the creative process and the tears shed when Leia finalizes the piece and needs to set the art object free.

The installation features a series of transparent resin spheres encompassing several ceramic sculptures, wrapped around the artist's hair. Each sphere is representing an art object at different stages in the creative process, from the initial spark of inspiration to the final object, connected by a system of flowing blood, the life-giving force that brings the artist's creations to life.

This installation is inspired by the imagery of a woman's womb, the art of creation, and the unbreakable bond between a mother and her child. The transparent spheres represent the potential for a new life, while the flowing blood symbolizes the life-giving, the energy that brings the artist's ideas to fruition.

The ever-flowing tears are a testament of the artist's emotional connection to her creations, and the sense of pride and loss that comes with completing a work of art. The installation invites viewers to contemplate the relationship between the artist and their creations, and to consider the emotional investment that goes into giving life to a new art object.
